

### **TPS Green Credits Terms and Conditions**

1. **Eligibility Criteria for TPS Green Credits:** The TPS Green Credits are applicable and limited to existing Tuas Power Supply Pte Ltd ("TPS") customers ("Customers") who meet the following criteria:
  - (a) **Invitation:** Only Customers who have received the invitation letter are eligible.
  - (b) **Workshop Completion:** Customers must have completed the CSOaaS program by 31 December 2025 / SMF, or such other date as determined by TPS and/or SMF at their discretion
  - (c) **Validity Period:** 1 July 2025 to 31 December 2025 (inclusive), or such other dates as determined by TPS and/or SMF at their discretion
  - (d) **Energy Consumption:** Average monthly energy consumption over the past three (3) months during the time when the program is offered, is greater than 0.5MW (= or >372 MWh)
  - (e) **Service Contract with SMF:** Customers must sign a Sustainability Report (SR) service contract and make full payment to SMF by 31 December 2025, or such other date as determined by TPS and/or SMF at their discretion
2. **TPS Green Credits:** The applicable amount of TPS Green Credits shall be determined based on the remaining duration of the Customers' electricity contract with TPS as at 1 July 2025.
  - (a) For Existing Contracts: Where the Customer's existing electricity supply contract with TPS has more than six (6) months prior to the expiry date, the Customer shall be entitled to receive S\$1,000.00 TPS Green Credits.
  - (b) New sign-ups or renewals: The applicable TPS Green Credits shall be as follows:
    - (i) For a twelve (12) month contract, the Customer shall receive S\$1,000.00 TPS Green Credits.
    - (ii) For a twenty-four (24) month contract, Customer shall receive S\$2,000.00 TPS Green Credits.
    - (iii) For a thirty-six (36) month contract, Customer shall receive S\$3,000.00 TPS Green Credits.
3. **Form of Provision:** TPS Green Credits will be provided to the Customer by way of reimbursement to their monthly electricity invoices.
4. **Reimbursement Documentation:** Reimbursement of the applicable one-time TPS Green Credits is contingent upon the provision of the following supporting documents:
  - (a) Signed Service Contract with SMF
  - (b) Tax invoice from SMF
  - (c) Sustainability Report of Chief Sustainability Officer-as-a-Service (CSOaaS) Programme
5. **Account Validity for Reimbursement:** At the time of reimbursement, the Customer's electricity account with TPS must remain active and in good standing, with a remaining contract of at least six (6) months, whether under an existing or renewed contracts.
6. **Non-Transferability and Modifications:** The TPS Green Credits are non-transferable, non-exchangeable and not redeemable for cash. TPS reserves the right, in its sole and absolute

discretion, to modify these Terms and Conditions from time to time without prior notice to any person.

7. **Clawback Provision:** TPS shall have the right to recover in full any and all reimbursement(s) extended to the Customer should their electricity supply contract with TPS be terminated prematurely for any reason whatsoever.
8. **Consent to Marketing:** By participating in the TPS Green Credits program, the Customer expressly consents to TPS utilising the Customer's information (e.g name) for marketing and promotional purposes pertaining to sustainability initiatives and other services offered by TPS.
9. **Disclaimer:** TPS shall not be held liable for the quality, suitability, or accuracy of any advice provided by SMF or for the content and accuracy of any reports issued by SMF.
10. **Termination of Program:** TPS reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to terminate, suspend, or discontinue the TPS Green Credits program at any time, for any reason, with or without prior notice to the Customers. In the event of such termination, suspension, or discontinuation, TPS shall not be liable to any Customer for any loss or damage arising therefrom, save for any TPS Green Credits that have already been validly accrued and approved for reimbursement prior to the effective date of such termination, suspension, or discontinuation.
11. **Governing Law and Dispute Resolution:** These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Singapore. Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or in connection with these Terms and Conditions, including any question regarding their existence, validity, or termination, shall be referred to and finally resolved by the courts of Singapore.
12. **Entire Agreement:** These Terms and Conditions constitute the entire agreement between TPS and the Customer concerning the TPS Green Credits program and supersede all prior or contemporaneous communications, understandings, and agreements, whether oral or written, between the parties regarding the subject matter hereof.
13. **Severability:** If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect under any applicable law, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.
